PROJECT BACKGROUND

Brandenburg was contracted to remove asbestos, solvents, adhesives, buildings, and foundations at 3M's 63-acre tape plant. The project included the removal of nearly 1,000,000 square feet of buildings, 23 underground storage tanks, and four above-ground storage tanks. Brandenburg's mobile crusher processed 60,000 tons of concrete generated from the building structures, slabs, utility lines, and foundations. The processed concrete was used to backfill excavations and grade the site. The final result was a highly marketable piece of estate close to Chicago's expressways, rail lines, and airports.

SCOPE OF WORK

Removed all asbestos-containing material

Removed and disposed of all solvents and adhesives

Demolished all above-ground structures

Excavated and removed 23 underground storage tanks

Demolished four above-ground storage tanks

Excavated and removed all foundations and processed concrete

Excavated and remediated all contaminated soil

Excavated and graded land
