PROJECT BACKGROUND

Atlantic Resource Corporation was a former precious metal recycling facility listed on the National Priorities List under CERCLA (Superfund). In 2002, Brandenburg was retained by Brown and Caldwell, an environmental engineering firm representing a group of potentially responsible parties for the decontamination, remediation, and demolition of the USEPA Region 2 Superfund site, located in Sayreville NJ.

SCOPE OF WORK

Construct an access road, field office, and decontamination zone

Remove, package, load, and dispose of all asbestos containing waste material

Decontaminate and remove eight recycling furnaces

Perform all necessary sampling, testing, and disposal of suspect material

Dismantle above ground tanks and associated piping

Demolish several 2-story brick buildings to floor slab

Perform underground tank excavation, removal, and disposal

Remove other miscellaneous structures and perform site work

Prepare all necessary permits

Prepare and submit all necessary reports to EPA representative

Remove, segregate, package, and dispose of all waste streams
