## PROJECT BACKGROUND

Brandenburg was contracted to perform the demolition of the Department of Sanitation 73rd Street Incinerator. The 174,878-square foot, 4-story structure was more recently utilized as a parking and storage structure for the Department of Sanitation. Due to the age and current condition, it was determined that the existing structure would be demolished in preparation for the construction of a new facility that is better suited for the Department of Sanitation's needs.

The structure was located adjacent to FDR Drive, one of New York City's busiest highways. This required the use of a specially engineered scaffolding system as well as close coordination with the Department of Transportation to ensure that traffic flow could continue uninterrupted.

Brandenburg met the equal employment opportunity requirements of the City of New York as stated in Executive Order No. 50 (1980) as amended (E.O. 50), its implementing Rules (Rules), and Chapter 56 of the City Charter (Chapter 57).

Demolished above-grade portions of the structure to the top of the existing building slab

Removed underground storage tanks

Segregated, loaded, and hauled materials off site

Controlled dust emission

Controlled and monitored noise levels
