PROJECT BACKGROUND

This 900,000 square foot structure with an attached six-story office built at the turn of the century was one of the largest rail freight terminals in the United States. Concrete floors were over 20" thick. Brandenburg performed the work without disrupting the adjacent Maxwell Street Market.

SCOPE OF WORK

Designed and implemented a site-wide asbestos abatement plan

Installed reinforced concrete bulkheads in the 40-foot deep Chicago Freight Tunnel System

Demolished over 70,000 cubic yards of brick and concrete

Recycled all brick and concrete by crushing to 3/4" and then spread to grade level on site

Dynamically compacted 200,000 square feet of the site and restored grade with crushed material for construction of a commercial facility
