PROJECT BACKGROUND

BHP Copper, Inc. contracted Brandenburg to raze their 650-acre processing facility located at the 7000-acre mine site in San Manuel, Arizona. This project was completed in two phases and is considered one of the world's largest mine closure. Due to the remote location, Brandenburg utilized their self-fabricated railcars to transport scrap from the site.



SCOPE OF WORK

Demolished the crusher building, ball mill, acid plant, smelter, concentrator, coarse oar building, tank building, and other miscellaneous structures

Demolished all associated piping and conveyer systems

Removed selected foundations and slabs on grade

Located and removed buried scrap and disposed equipment in mine area

Recovered assets and salvaged selected equipment

Removed two 500-foot tall concrete stacks
